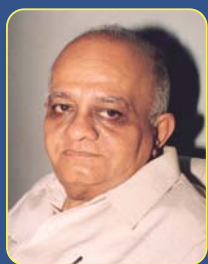


THE THIRTEENTH V. G. Kulkarni Memorial Lecture

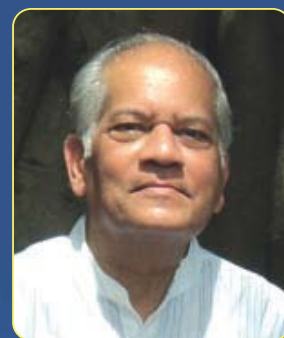
